

Over the last couple of years the Scottish Government has been phasing in an enhanced Preventive programme for young

children. This has involved a co-ordinated approach from Oral Health educators, Health visitors, Primary Schools and General Dental Practices.

We are pleased to announce that, as of this summer, we will be part of this. Over the next year we will carry out a series of promotions and the first one involves helping the parents of our under 5's with ensuring their children are given a sound knowledge of toothbrushing. This will involve demonstrations of different techniques as well as a review of your family's current methods.

Children do not have the fine motor skills needed to brush properly until at least the age of seven. We, therefore, advise that all parents help their children with this skill until at least age 7. We suggest that you involve your children in the process in an age appropriate way, encouraging them to form good habits for the future by finding out what motivates them (just like everything else!) if at all possible it is advisable to schedule brushing at a time when your child is not tired. As all our adult members know flossing is a more intricate art and we suggest only applicable for teenage years and beyond.
